September 28th, January 3rd and March 7th are Staff Development Days from Stockpile. Staff Development Days from Stockpile are part of the 180 required days and are not In-Service Days. On September 28th and March 7th the time period from 3:15 to 6:15 will count ½ day In-Service each day to meet the requirement of one day for Parent-Teacher Conferences.
